Saturated (solution) A solution containing the maximum amount of solute that will dissolve at a given temperature. water to make 500. mL of solution. Decrease the temperature to 35°C, or add 25 g more solute. 36. Of the two points on the line, point F must represent the point of saturation because the solution became saturated and the temperature increased from the exothermic solution process. 37. As the temperature increases, the solubility of SO<sub>2</sub> decreases.
